Make a list and use it to thank God when your family prays together. Praise God that you can put your trust in Him.

God Shows His Power



God told Pharaoh to let the Israelites go free. God wanted his people to worship him in their own land. But Pharaoh would not obey God's command.

So God showed his mighty power of judgment by sending plagues to Egypt. He changed the water of the Nile River into blood. He sent frogs hopping all over the land. He made gnats and flies bother the Egyptians. Their animals became sick and died. Even so, Pharaoh said, "No" to God's command.

God sent more plagues. He wanted to teach Pharaoh and the people that he is Lord and that he has power over everything. God caused painful sores to come on the bodies of the Egyptians. Then God sent a hailstorm that ruined their crops. Next a swarm of locusts came and ate everything growing on trees and in the fields. Still Pharaoh would not obey God.

So God sent a deep darkness over Egypt for three days. But God's people had light where they lived.

God protected his people and them safe from the plagues. He was getting ready to keep his promise to lead his people out of Egypt. Pharaoh could not stop God from keeping his Word. God's power is very great. We can trust our powerful God.
