Want to know why we include lots of different activities in the Bible lesson? More info on the back . . .

The Why:

The short answer is repetition is a very effective teaching tool for Preschool age children and to reach each learning style! (Auditory, Visual, Kinesthetic...hear, see, do)

Why **read** the story to your child, **make** a craft and do an **activity** related to each lesson? By **making a craft** with their hands it will help your child further process the truth for the week, **help it sink in** and give them a tangible reminder when they see it. Display it in their room, the kitchen, the play room, etc - anywhere they will see it and be reminded! Then we **do an activity or play a game to reinforce the lesson**. Some children learn best while they are actively engaging the lesson. Think of those who don't like to sit still! We also **read the Bible story**. Children this age love to be read to and what better thing to read than the Word of God? They are sponges at this age so let's pour the truth into them! Another great way to **reinforce Biblical truths is through song**. Ever catch yourself humming a tune or have lyrics running through your head? This is another great way to teach your child. I have put together a playlist on Spotify. (You can set up a free account if you don't have one.) Be careful, you might find yourself singing them too!
